STORM DETAILS:

- The powerful tornado first touched down in Newcastle and churned toward Interstate 44 and S.W. 149th Street. At least three people have been killed and multiple injuries have been reported.
- 3 times the strength of the 1999 storm; wider swath, but not on the ground as long
